<p>READING (quality of the structure & content) _____%</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> This is a RANT – to an audience of your peers, tone needs to be appropriate to audience and the topic, must be about a current a current issue</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Introduction includes a strong and engaging <i>LEAD</i> and a brief intro to the topic</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Body is made up of discussion of the issue with examples from THEN and NOW to compare and contrast</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Conclusion ENDS ON MESSAGE by sharing your stance on this issue today, and what you have to say about our culture, the way we live, and the human condition. Are we better off than we were then, or not? How so? Don't forget to finish with a witty turn of phrase using wordplay, pun, etc.</p>	Advanced	Thorough	Acceptable

<p>TALK (quality of the presentational style) _____%</p> <p>_____ Time management: respects the 2 minute limit</p> <p>Spoken Codes and Conventions</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Attitude: act confident, be prepared, don't waste time, get organized – cue up your meme</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Charisma: are you interesting to listen to? Bring the personality & enthusiasm</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Voice: tone of voice, volume and projection, intonation patterns, clarity, pronunciation</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Rhetorical strategies: anecdote, analogy, humour, historical / current events / literary referents, ability to relate & create rapport, explain and interest, examples...</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Pacing & Rhythm: pace, phrasing, pauses & silences</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Body language: commanding attention, facial expressions, eye contact, no fidgeting, poise..</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Grammar (correctness), syntax, diction, and vocabulary: are appropriate to the talk, eg colloquialisms, examples, errors are for effect, not because you don't know...</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Organization: rationale for prioritizing and sequencing ideas; flow, coherence, and unity.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Knowledgeability: NO NOTES – know your stuff, be able to get back on track AND be able to field questions</p>	88 – 100% (5)	74-87% (4)	60-73% (3)
